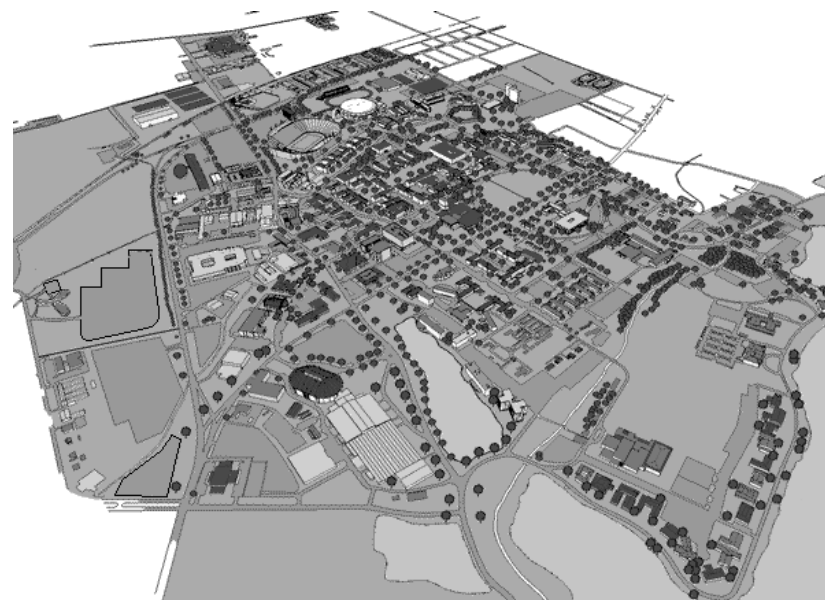

**Rules and Regulations**

1. Payment: No entries will be accepted and no stalls reserved unless accompanied by payment in full of stall and entry fees. All horses must be stalled. An open check is acceptable and made payable to Louisiana Fall Festival Horse Show.
2. Refunds: In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the stall fees are NOT REFUNDABLE. Any request to withdraw horses after Thursday, November 5<sup>th</sup> and prior to Friday, November 6, 2009 must be supported with a veterinarian certificate giving a COMPREHENSIVE DIAGNOSIS. Entry fees may be refunded or credited only on receipt of such veterinary certificate.
3. Entries: The word "ENTRY" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must contain the name and full description of each horse or pony and the class in which it is to be entered. All entries must be made on the official ENTRY BLANK and signed by the owner/trainer and/or rider/driver/handler. A number will be assigned to each horse or rider at the time the entry is received and will stand for the entire show and must be displayed whenever the horse or rider is in the ring.
4. Scratches: All scratches must be made 2 hours prior to show time.
5. ASHA Registration: A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership, or a copy of the registration with the Certificate of Eligibility to Show issued by the American Saddlebred Horse Association, must be presented to the horse show office before the show number is released.
6. Damages: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will be charged accordingly.
7. Stalls: Stalls will be available from Tuesday, November 3, 2009 through Sunday, November 8, 2009. Early arrival is considered to be arriving anytime Tuesday, Nov. 3 or Wednesday, Nov. 4, 2009 with stalls available at a charge of \$25 per stall per day. No stalls will be reserved unless accompanied by entries and payment in full for both stalls and entries. Bedding will be available through the horse show office at a charge of \$7.50/bag. No outside bedding may be brought onto the premises. Stall assignments are at the discretion of the show management.
8. Office Fee: A \$20 office fee will be charged per horse/academy rider and equitation rider. This amount is non-refundable.

9. Holds: Holds must be requested in writing at least one (1) hour in advance of each session. Holds will be limited to two (2) minutes. Emergency holds must be given to the Paddock Master with the request signed by an authorized representative of the entry.
10. Rules: Every class offered herein will be conducted in the spirit of USEF rules and judged in accordance therewith. The show manager/committee will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. To compete in a championship class participants must have entered, shown and be judged in a qualifying class.
11. Horses: All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the judge may, if he so desires, have the horse examined by the show veterinarian, and the judge's decision will be final. NO Exhibitor may use a Veterinarian's Statement to contradict the judge's decision.
12. Show Committee: Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the show manager/committee whose decision will be final. The show manager/committee reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Three entries are necessary to fill a class unless otherwise specified, or the class may be declared void, at the option of the manager/committee. If the entries in two or more classes of the same division are not sufficient to fill, the committee reserves the right to combine the same into one competition.
13. Liability: The LFFHS, LASHA, show manager/committee, LSU nor any sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, rider, driver, groom, attendant, animal or equipment at the show. WARNING: Under Louisiana Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or death of a participant in equine activities, pursuant to R.S. 9:2795.1
14. Show Ring: No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official or requested duties to perform. No horse will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted in the show office.
15. Discipline: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, Driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to such disqualified horse.
16. Disputes: Should any question arise that is not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to the show manager/committee whose decision shall be final.
17. Dress: All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering the ring.

18. Pets: Pets must remain on leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility. Dogs are NOT allowed in the arena seating area or the warm-up ring.
19. Negative Coggins: A valid negative Coggins test within one year of the show must accompany each horse and must be available for inspection by Louisiana Inspectors at the show grounds.
20. Prize Money: Premiums will be paid by check and will be mailed to the address of the agent of record by December 1, 2009.
21. Parking: All trucks, vans, trailers, and RV's after unloading, must park in the designated parking areas.
22. Checks: All checks should be made payable to the Louisiana Fall Festival Horse Show. Returned checks will incur a \$50.00 handling fee. No one will be allowed to show who has a bad check or handling fee outstanding.
23. Ring Procedures: The gate to the show ring will remain open 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Due to the unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a PA malfunction.
24. Children should be under parental supervision at all times, and not in areas not open to the public.
25. Campers: Camper hookups are available for \$35.00 per night for 50 amp service. Reservations must be made in advance by contacting Jean Carnal at 504-250-5494.
26. No bicycles, skateboards, skates, or non motorized scooters are allowed on the show grounds.

Horses should be of the Standardbred type, of attractive appearance, balanced in confirmation and with manners that make a safe risk in the ring. Horses and ponies must be serviceably sound and shown without artificial appliances except boots and inconspicuously applied tail switches. Horses and ponies are to be exhibited in an appropriate harness to a two wheeled vehicle and should exhibit brilliance and show ring presence. Roadster ponies are restricted to ponies 50" (12.2 hands) or less.

To be shown to a two wheel bike except in the under saddle classes, at the jog, trot, road gait and then at speed. Drivers to wear stable colors, caps and jackets to match
